Nursery – Learning Overview Autumn Term

Topic: All About Me

PRIME AREAS	
Communication and Language Listening, Attention and Understanding and Speaking Provide varied opportunities for children to: - Enjoy listening to longer stories and remember much of what happens. - Sing a large repertoire of songs and rhymes - Understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as: 'Get your coat and wait at the door'. 	
Personal, Social and Emotional Development Self-regulation, Managing Self and Building Relationships Support children to develop personal, social and emotional skills so that they: - Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'sad' - Increasingly follow rules, understand why they are important - Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting. - Show more confidence in new social situations. - Understand gradually how others might be feeling. 	Physical Development Gross Motor Skills and Fine Motor Skills Provide varied opportunities for children to develop their gross motor skills through: - Continuing to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills. - Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues. Provide varied opportunities for children to develop their fine motor skills through - Showing a preference for a dominant hand. - Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors.  
SPECIFIC AREAS	
Literacy - Understand that print has meaning. - Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories. - Enjoy sharing books with an adult. - Understand that print can have different purposes. 	Maths - Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.  - Take part in finger rhymes with numbers.

Count or clap syllables in a word. 	- Extend and create ABAB patterns. - Recite numbers past 5. - Understand positional language. - Make comparisons between objects relating to size. 
Understanding the World - Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history. - Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials. - Show interest in different occupations. 	Expressive Arts and Design - Explore different materials freely, to develop their ideas about how to use them and what to make. - Listen with increased attention to sounds. - Take part in simple pretend play. - Explore colour and colour mixing.
